## **SLURRY SEAL NOTICE - OCTOBER 2016**

# <u>The Stoneridge Board of Directors has scheduled the slurry seal coating on October 10<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>. Please review the attached map showing when your street will <u>be done.</u></u>

### Please be sure to observe the following items and plan accordingly:

• <u>All vehicles must be out of the Slurry areas by 7:00 a.m.</u> on the scheduled day for your street. Your vehicle (including motorcycles, bicycles etc.) may not return to the affected area until the following day. All of your vehicles should be moved out of the area prior to the start of the slurry coating process. This means if you need to use your vehicle that is parked in your garage, it must be moved out of your garage prior to 7:00 a.m. and may not return until the barriers are removed the next day. If you choose to leave a vehicle in your garage while the slurry coating is being applied and cured on your street, you must not remove the garaged vehicle until the contractor removes the street barriers.


### ANY VEHICLES PARKED ON THE STREET IN THE SCHEDULED AREA WILL BE TOWED AT THE VEHICLE OWNER'S EXPENSE.

- Affected vehicles *may be parked in any unaffected area within the Stoneridge Community* that is not scheduled for slurry seal coating.
- **Do not walk or drive on the wet seal coat**. The slurry company should put up temporary barriers on the streets and sidewalks. When the contractor removes them, it is safe to drive on the freshly sealed streets.
- Please turn off your sprinklers the night before and the day of your seal date so the water does not run into the street.
- Do not schedule any special deliveries, contractors, or moving trucks, as no vehicle access will be permitted into the slurry seal areas. Please contact any household service personnel (i.e. landscaper, house cleaner, etc.) to reschedule service if necessary.
- Once the barriers are down, you may drive on the streets. However, as the seal coat will remain flexible for approximately four (4) weeks, be cautious when turning car wheels. Vehicles should continue to roll while turning wheels and also avoid turning wheels while vehicle is not in motion. Any damage caused by a homeowner, their family members or their guests, due to misuse of their car on the freshly sealed streets, will be charged to the homeowner for all costs to repair the street.
- On the day the entry gates will be sealed, Owners and guests will be directed to the alternative gate.
